

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Within walking distance of the Allenheads Inn and other village amenities, the cottage provides a fantastic base within which to explore the surrounding countryside. Hadrian's Wall, Kielder, Hexham and the Lake District are all a short distance away. The area is famous for its beautiful walks and cycle rides, indeed Allenheads is halfway on the C2C cycle route from Whitehaven to Sunderland.

The cottage has full double glazing and is heated throughout by electric storage radiators. The beds have cosy, warm duvets and bed linen and towels are provided for your stay. All electricity costs are included in the price, however if you would like to use the stove there is an additional charge for fuel. There is off-road parking and cycles are available to hire by prior arrangement.

Mole Catcher's Cottage is a recently renovated cosy cottage with a contemporary twist. With its own walled garden the cottage is situated in the heart of the secret North Pennines, in the village of Allenheads.

Beamed throughout, the cottage has one double and one twin bedroom, a living room with wood burning stove and a charming modern kitchen and bathroom.

We can supply additional activities during your stay. The following are examples: **gorge walking, guided tours, guided walks, golf, rock climbing, fishing, horse riding, canoeing.**

Allendale Village, nearby, has an annual Summer Fair and a spectacular Tar Barrel Burning Parade on New Year's Eve. Skiing and snowboarding is available during the winter months dependant upon snowfall.



As an added bonus you may be fortunate enough to spot a Red Squirrel as this is one of only a few locations in the country where you can still find these rare animals in their natural habitat.
